MES Tablet Mount

Secure mounting for iPad, Android and Windows Tablets and touch screen monitors is available through a multitude of vendors.

Guardian does not recommend, nor support any specific mounting hardware or enclosure for iPads and tablets. This document simply provides possible solutions.

MES Tablets typically require a wall mount bracket of some kind as well as a secure enclosure.

Articulated Wall Mount

The Articulated Wall Mount is the preferred method for mounting a tablet to a work center. The wall mount should have an articulated arm to provide easy positioning for the user and typically extending less than 20". Wall mounts should have standard VESA mounting holes for easy, non-modified installation. VESA mounting is standard throughout the computer industry and provides a standard location for mounting holes in the back of monitors and tablet enclosures.

Secure Tablet Enclosure

A secure enclosure is required for the ability to mount the tablet/iPad to the articulated arm wall mount. Enclosures come in many different styles and configurations. Make sure that the enclosure you choose has standard VESA mounting holes. It has been suggested that enclosures designed for the specific tablet in use tend to be easier to install than those that are generic.

The iPad Alloy Holder by Vantage Point is available for \$75.00 and is very popular with Guardian users because of its durability and ability to be mounted directly to a wall or stud without the need of additional hardware.
